VANCOUVER | 2 Nights

With its stunning setting between the North Shore Mountains and the Strait of Georgia, Vancouver is Canada’s most ethnically diverse city. Many of its residents are of Asian descent, an influence prevalent in the city’s restaurants, traditions and gardens, such as the famed Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden. Still, Vancouver is Canadian through and through, with a rich Native American past and a frontier history built on the famed gold rush of the mid-1800s. Its vibrant cultural institutions run the gamut from bustling markets such as the Granville Island Public Market, to museums that chronicle the region’s anthropology and cultural riches, to the film studios that have earned the city the moniker “Hollywood North.” Two nights in a First-Class hotel in Vancouver, daily breakfasts, a half-day city tour and all transfers are included, along with the services of a Viking host.
